- Aligned with the style guide
- Components
- AngularJS 1.6
 - No modules

Stable

- Lots of old practices
- Shared libs
 - Feature modules

Dependencies



Dependency Triage

- Take inventory
- Determine:
 - Ditch
 - Upgrade
 - Rewrite

Build



Noble

- Gulp
- ES6 & Babel
- Standard

Stable

- Script tags and Grunt
 - ES5
- Very complex

BOTH NEED TO FACTOR
IN TYPESCRIPT AND A
BUNDLER!

Testing

Noble

- Unit tests, but not critical
 - A few Protractor
- UAT potential

Stable

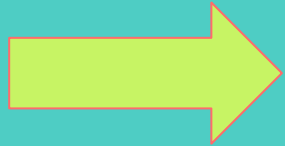
- Many critical unit tests
- Many critical Protractor
- Some UAT

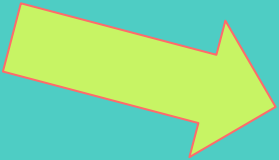
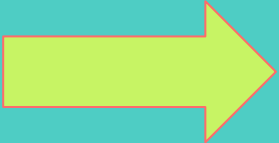
